Antonio Carcano called Carcani or Carcany (circa 1755-1820)

Carved and gilded wood

H: 100 cm – 39 ½ inches W: 43 cm – 17 inches D: 5 cm – 2 inches



11. Fountain with pinecone and mask decoration.

Painted and gilded toleware

France, Louis XVI period, 1789

Sèvres manufactory

Mark with the royal figure (two *LL* facing each other); letter-date : *MM* for 1789; mark of the painter (*L*), **Denis Levé (1754-1805)**; mark of the gilder (*R*), probably **Boileau cadet**; unidentifiable in recess mark 6 at the top and 38 at the bottom

Soft porcelain

Provenance : Delivered for Marie-Thérèse de Savoie, Comtesse d'Artois (1756-1805) on June 27, 1789 for Versailles

H: 17,5 cm – 6 3/4 inches D: 23,5 cm – 9 1/4 inches



13. Polished steel candleholder

Russia, Tula manufactory, late 18th century – early 19th century

Steel, enhanced with brass and pewter

Russia, Tula manufactory, late 18th century-early 19th century
Steel, gilt and chased bronze, enhanced with brass and pewter

Provenance: Former Alphonse de Rothschild's (1827-1905) collection

15. Polished steel casket

Russia, Tula manufactory, late 18th century-early 19th century

Steel, gilt and chased bronze, enhanced with brass and pewter

H: 4,7 cm – 1 7/8 inches W: 9 cm – 3 1/2 inches D: 6,7 cm – 2 5/8 inches



16. Clock in Locré biscuit

42.000 euros

France, last quarter of the 18th century

Attributed to **Jacques-Thomas Bréant (1753-1807)**

Locré manufactory

Hard porcelain biscuit, chased and gilt bronze

H: 30 cm – 11 3/4 inches W: 24,5 cm – 9 1/2 inches D: 13,5 cm – 5 1/4 inches



17. Curule armchair

France, Directoire-Consulat period, 1796-1803

Stamped *Jacob-Frères rue Meslée*

Jacob-Frères 1796-1803

Georges II (1768-1803) and Honoré-Georges Jacob (1770-1841)

Solid mahogany and mahogany veneer

H: 92 cm – 36 inches W: 63 cm – 25 inches D: 52 cm – 20 1/2 inches
